



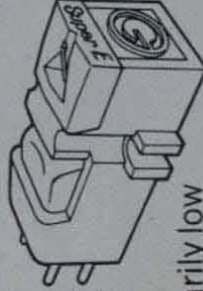
### The GL 85

This completely new Lenco transcription unit sets new standards of perfection.

It incorporates all the technical innovations which make it easy to achieve that kind of quality for which the only possible substitute is the original sound itself. And from handsome plinth to clear dust cover, it is housed in the style to which it has every right to become accustomed.

The GL 85 has all the features of design and performance which will quickly secure it a place as the transcription unit of the Hi-Fi connoisseur.

And it needs a stereo-magnetic cartridge of equal quality. Shown here is the Goldring 800 Super E. A cartridge with extraordinarily low mechanical impedance, and a performance aimed to satisfy the perfectionist.



### Facts about the GL 85

Two speeds, 33 $\frac{1}{3}$  and 45 r.p.m., with new electronically controlled fine

speed adjustment of  $\pm 3\%$ .

New low-speed 16-pole synchronous motor, providing exceptional accuracy, transfers the drive via non-stretch flat belt. Illuminated stroboscope skilfully set in the turntable.

Electronic shut-off mechanism switches the current off at the end of the record and raises the arm from the playing surface without mechanical interference.

Wow and flutter both remarkably low. Rumble an astonishingly low 60 dB weighted.

The unit shown here is mounted on handsome hand-finished wood plinth. Attractive dust cover is available.
