Re HDMI Resolution

The NAD T515 includes a video scalar that will allow the standard resolution (480i/576i) to be increased to 480p/576p/720p/1080i when outputting a HDMI signal

“TIP (as it reads in addendum)

When you use HDMI connection, you can change the resolution (480p/576p, 720p, 1080i) for the HDMI output by pressing RESOLUTION. 480i/576i is not available. You can only change the resolution within your TV's and Monitor's resolution capabilities. For S-VIDEO OUT connection, black and white scramble signal will appear if you select an incompatible resolution.”

Please note: Limited scaling to 720p can be done via the component outputs but only when non copy protected discs are being played. This feature is most useful when playing home movies recorded to DVD disc and does not apply to most pre recorded movies.

Please note: When scaling is activated on HDMI or Component outputs all other video outputs are de-activated.
