## Important safety instructions

*Ensure that you read all of the safety instructions before using this unit.*

### Safety Considerations

- Position the power cable and other connected cables so that they are not likely to be walked on, pinched or where items can be placed on or against them.
- Do not use the unit in humid or damp conditions.
- Do not allow the unit to get wet.
- Never allow children to insert foreign objects into holes or slots on the unit.
- Do not cover the ventilation with items such as tablecloths, curtains, etc. This may cause overheating.
- No naked flame sources, such as lit candles, should be placed on or near the unit.
- Do not expose the unit to dripping or splashing water, and no objects filled with liquids, such as vases, should be placed on or near the apparatus.
- Do not place the unit in closed cabinet without proper ventilation.

### Cleaning

- Disconnect the unit from the mains supply before cleaning.
- Do not use any liquids or aerosol cleaners, as this may damage the unit. Use a soft, dust free cloth.

## Before you begin

Congratulations on purchasing your MILAN Bluetooth wireless technology stereo amplified audio system! This product can provide you hours of music enjoyment by allowing you to wirelessly stream audio content from your mobile device such as a mobile phone or tablet or computer. No longer do you need to have your mobile phone tethered to your audio system. You can roam around the house or office while texting, or gaming, or using some other functions of your mobile phone, while still listening to the great music played back through your MILAN audio system. You can also charge your mobile devices through the USB port, or even listen to other portable audio sources such as mp3 players through the auxiliary line input.

The mobile device must support Bluetooth version 2.1 + EDR and A2DP(Advanced Audio Distribution Profile). Not all mobile devices can support multitasking such as listening to music and texting at the same time. Not all mobile phones will be compatible with the charging ports.

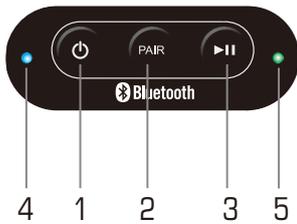

### Plugging in for power

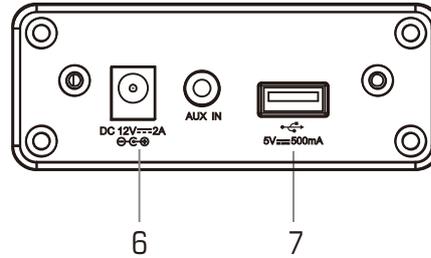
Connect the supplied power adapter to the MILAN's Power jack, and connect the other end to a convenient wall outlet.

## General controls

Top view



Rear view



1. -Turn on/off the MILAN
2. PAIR Enter Pairing mode
3. Start/pause audio playback of your Bluetooth device
4. Blue/Red LED Turns on when Bluetooth wireless is activated
5. Green LED Turns on when AUX IN is activated
6. USB jack that charge your tablet device or cell phone.  
(USB charging cable not included)
7. Connect to the power adapter.

## Pairing

Any Bluetooth device that you wish to have streaming audio to your MILAN must first be PAIRED to the MILAN. The process is simple, and in most cases the PAIRING process needs to be done only once. Pairing your Bluetooth wireless technology enabled products with the MILAN:

1. Activate the Bluetooth wireless mode on your Bluetooth device (smartphone, Laptop, PC) and let the device enter search mode. Refer to the device user manual for more details.
2. Press to turn on the MILAN
3. The MILAN enters the pairing mode (red and blue LED flash alternatively) automatically at the first start up. If this is not the first time you use the MILAN, press and hold the PAIR button on the MILAN to enter Pairing mode. The red and blue LED will flash alternately and an audio signal will be provided to let you know you can release the button.
4. You should be able to see "MILAN" on the device list in the Bluetooth settings menu on your Bluetooth device where you can complete the pairing operation. Note in some cases you may be prompted to enter a passkey. The passkey is "0000". The bluetooth settings menu or bluetooth device list will be found in different ways for different devices depending on the brand and operating system.

You can manually break the Bluetooth wireless connection by a press and hold of the PAIR button.

- Some Bluetooth devices will automatically start streaming audio when connected.
- The MILAN can store settings for up to 8 Bluetooth devices which simplifies the connection process for these devices without the need for re pairing every time
- The term "Bluetooth device" is used frequently in these instructions. So what is a "Bluetooth device"?  
The answer is simple. This would be any mobile phone or mobile tablet or netbook or computer which has at least both of the following capabilities:
  - a) Is equipped with Bluetooth wireless technology: Bluetooth version 2.1 + EDR and A2DP.
  - b) Can playback audio content such as mp3 files, etc.

## Reconnecting

In the previous section you saw how to make that first connection between your Bluetooth device and the MILAN. However, since most people don't leave their mobile phone at home all the time, or perhaps the mobile phone is turned off from time to time, it will be necessary to reconnect your previously paired Bluetooth device when you wish to stream music again. There are a few different ways in which reconnections are made, and fortunately they are all very simple.

### Searching mode

When the MILAN is in **SEARCHING MODE** (which is indicated by a flashing of the Blue LED), the MILAN is attempting to automatically connect to the most recently connected Bluetooth device. **SEARCHING MODE** typically occurs when the MILAN is first turned on, or if the Bluetooth device goes out of the range. See the Bluetooth range section on Bluetooth wireless technology range. Once this most recent device is back within range, the re-connection should be automatic. However, it may be necessary to initiate the audio playback on the Bluetooth device. Note that the Searching mode will revert to Bluetooth Standby Mode (see next section) if no re-connection is made.

Bluetooth Standby mode If the most recently connected Bluetooth device can not be found during Searching Mode, then the MILAN will revert to **BLUETOOTH STANDBY MODE**. While in this mode, the MILAN will accept connection from any previously paired Bluetooth devices (up to 8 devices). Simply initiate the connection to the MILAN on your Bluetooth device. See your Bluetooth device for more information.

Bluetooth range The Bluetooth wireless technology generally can operate within a range of 33 feet or more. However results may vary based on other factors such as your Bluetooth device performance, room layout, wall material, weather conditions, etc. Also, note that when a mobile device goes out of range, the MILAN will enter Searching mode and will attempt to automatically reconnect to the mobile device when that mobile device comes back into range within 5 minutes. (See Searching Mode section for more information)

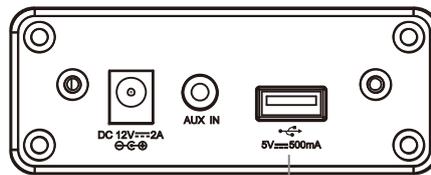
- You can always enter Pairing mode by pressing and holding **PAIR** while in either **SEARCHING MODE** or **BLUETOOTH STANDBY MODE**
- If during **SEARCHING MODE** (Blue LED is flashing), you wish to quickly connect any other Bluetooth device (including those previously paired), simply press/hold the **PAIR** button to enter **PAIRING** mode, and proceed to **PAIR** the Bluetooth device (see **PAIRING** section).
- Generally when the user disables the Bluetooth wireless connection on a connected Bluetooth device the MILAN will enter Bluetooth Standby mode which means that the MILAN would be available for other previously paired Bluetooth devices to connect (See Bluetooth Standby Mode section for more information). However, in some cases, the disabling of Bluetooth wireless connection on the connected Bluetooth device may not result in the MILAN immediately entering Bluetooth Standby mode, and may enter Searching Mode. (See Searching Mode section for more information)

## Music playback

When your Bluetooth device is connected with the MILAN, the blue LED lights. Press **▶||** to play/pause music on your device.

## USB charging

Use the USB jack on the back of the MILAN to charge your tablet, cell phone or other mobile device.



USB jack that charge your tablet device or cell phone.

Connect your tablet device or cell phone to the USB jack. Your device should start charging.

Charging function may not be supported for all phones, tablets or electronic devices

- Use the appropriate USB cable provided with your cell phone or tablet for charging
- Charging function is always enabled as long as the AC/DC adapter is plugged in and connected.

## Auxiliary source

1. To select auxiliary mode, connect your auxiliary source (e.g. mp3 player) to the AUX input jack at the back of the MILAN with a 3.5mm audio in cable (not supplied).
2. The green LED will turn on. Control all other playback operations from your auxiliary player.
3. To switch back to the Bluetooth connection, disconnect the 3.5mm cable from the AUX input jack at the back of the audio system.

The 3.5mm audio direct connection suspends any Bluetooth streaming audio you're listening to.

The MILAN plays only the direct connect audio when you have something connected to the AUX input jack.

## Troubleshooting and Technical Specification

Q: Cannot turn on the MILAN when charging.

A: The MILAN will shut down to protect itself from damage when charging is overloaded. To resume operation, disconnect the USB connection and turn on the MILAN again.

Q: Streaming stops and the Power LED turns off when plugging in device to the USB jack.

A: The MILAN will shut down to protect itself from damage when charging is overloaded. To resume operation, disconnect the USB connection and turn on the MILAN again.

Q: No sound or sound is very low.

A: Make sure the Bluetooth wireless connection is correct and playback has been successfully started. Check the volume level of your Bluetooth device. Make sure you have disconnected the 3.5 mm audio in cable from the AUX input jack.

Q: My paired Bluetooth device can not reconnect to the MILAN.

A: Press and hold PAIR to enter Pairing mode again. A reconnection may fail due to :

The pairing information has been deleted from your Bluetooth device.

You may have exceeded the allowable number of paired devices for the MILAN. Only 8 Bluetooth devices may have their pairing credentials stored at one time. Simply follow the above instructions for Pairing to have a device paired again. However remember that the MILAN can only store credentials for 8 devices. Therefore the earliest paired device will be removed from that list of 8 to make room for the device you wish to Pair.
