## 2. OPERATION OF EACH SELECTOR

The list shown below indicates the relation between input and output when turning over the selector switches. In the list, the mark  $\ominus$  shows outputs passing through Master volume and the Mark  $\circ$  signifies outputs by-passing Master volume and comes directly from input terminal to output terminal.

For Instance:

When input signal comes from tuner at recording mode, a signal by-passing Master volume appears at output terminal of Tape 1 Rec (Printed  $\bullet$  in the list below) only when the selector position is Recording Mode 1, in addition, output signal appears in any Mixing Selector position.

### 3. FUNCTIONS

#### 1) Input circuit

The input circuit is provided with the input jacks 1, 2, 3, and 4 on the front panel. The inputs, 1 and 2 are connected to the input circuit directly as shown in Block Diagram on page 1 (input sensitivity 1 mV/47 kΩ) designed to be used for Microphones, and the inputs, 3 and 4 are used for Microphone, Guitar and Line inputs (input sensitivity 1 mV, 20 mV, 150 mV/47 kΩ respectively), which can be switched over in accordance with the purpose of use. Therefore, this model, AX-7, can be operated always in the proper condition by changing over the input sensitivity to meet each application.

#### 2) Input attenuator

This attenuator of -20 dB is equipped on the first stage of input circuit shown in the Block Diagram, thereby the input signal is attenuated -20 dB before the first stage of amplifier, which prevent an excessive clipped input signal into the amplifier directly. Consequently, the dynamic range of the amplifier can be utilized to the full.

The attenuator works at each position of the input sensitivity changeover of the input 3 and 4, therefore, this set, AX-7, can be applied to further various input levels by the combination of switching ON the attenuator and the input sensitivity changeover (= of switching OFF the attenuator).

#### 3) Input level adjustment

Each level of the inputs 1, 2, 3 and 4 can be individually adjusted by the level volume control provided for left & right channels, which permits the use of Microphones with different sensitivities and also the individual level variation of Guitar, Line inputs, 3 and 4. In other words, the input levels can be adjusted in the best balance because input signal level of each channel, 1, 2, 3 & 4 can be controlled by the independently equipped volume control.

#### 4) Panpot function

This audio mixer, AX-7, has Panpot function which localizes, as you desire, the sound image of monophonic sound by signal given to input 1, 2, 3 or 4 between speakers L and R. Namely, this function allows to move the sound image as monaural sound continuously from one position to another between speakers, L and R during stereo reproduction. Therefore, the sound of each input signal into inputs, 1, 2, 3 & 4 can be moved desired sound-image localization between speakers, left and right by use of these function volumes, monitoring the reproduced stereo sound by signals given to L and R input terminals.

#### 5) Reverberation function

A reverberation unit applying spring elasticity to this function is built in this AX-7, and the reverberation time can be varied as required within the range from 1.9 to 3.2 seconds. A reverberation unit produces echo sound of one or more combined as 1, 1 and 2, 1 to 3 and 1 to 4, against the signals provided into inputs, 1, 2, 3 and 4 on the front panel.

#### 6) Low cut filter

When the frequency response extends too far into low-frequency band at public address, the separation of individual sound becomes worse. Even though low band is cut by this filter, sound quality is not harmed.

#### 7) Master volume control

The levels of signals from individual inputs, 1, 2, 3 & 4 adjusted by level volume and mixed by mixing selector are totally controlled by Master volume control. As the levels are adjusted under condition that the sound images are localized between speakers, left and right by means of the panpot function, the position of sound image between two speakers does not change, even though the sound levels are varied by master volume control.

Also, this volume control works only at mixing-out position of monitor selector, and markings are provided between the positions, 6 to 6.5 of this control to get same sound level comparing to that from the source input terminal.

#### 8) Recording mode

Three tape inputs, Tape-1, -2, -3 are provided, which permit simultaneous recording with three tape decks and tape dubbing from one deck to other. Irrelevant to the mixing-out position, recording of program sources such as FM broadcasting and discs, or tape dubbing from one to two decks can be performed. At the mixing-out position, the output signal controlled by the master volume is directly delivered to the REC terminals via recording mode switch.

#### 9) Adaptors

Other adaptors (e.g. QS synthesizer, meter or equalizer amplifier etc.) can be connected in series between integrated stereo amplifier and this AX-7. Two adaptors can be connected in series at the position, 1 → 2 of adaptor switch.

#### 10) Mixing Selector

This is a selection switch for mixing the signals of inputs, 1, 2, 3 and 4 with signal of the source from one of tape inputs, Tape-1, -2 or -3.

When mixing play is not needed and only input signals from input 1, 2, 3 & 4 are to be outputted, the off-position of this mixing selector is used.

#### 11) Mixing Balance

This control has the function to get the same levels between signal selected by the mixing selector and input signals from Inputs, 1, 2, 3 & 4 on the front panel.

By turning this balance volume clockwise or counterclockwise fully, either signal from source inputs, tuner, tape-1 to tape-3 or one from input-1, -2, -3 & -4 (mic, guitar, line) remains.


#### 12) Monitor Selector

This has the function to select output signal against input signals. At the source position, the signal from source input is directly given to OUTPUT terminals on rear panel. At the mixing-out position, the output signal balanced by the mixing balance control is delivered to the OUTPUT terminals. At this position, the master volume control functions, therefore, the total sound levels are controlled by the master volume control. And at the positions of Tape-1, Tape-2 & Tape-3, the output signal of each tape deck is directly sent to OUTPUT terminals.










