


IMPORTANT: Turn the unit OFF during disassembly and part replacement. Recheck all work before you apply power to the unit.




■ SW-P201 BLOCK DIAGRAM








■ SW-P201 PRINTED CIRCUIT BOARD (Component side)












IC2, 3, 7, 8 : μ PC4570HA Dual OP-Amp








IC5 : μPC1237HA Protector IC for Power Amplifier




IC6: M51848L CR Timer
